Key highlights of the program included:



HON. ATALBIHARI VAJPAYI JAYANTI

DATE- 25/12/2025

Hon. Atal Bihari Vajpayee (25 December 1924 – 16 August 2018) was one of India's most respected statesmen, a visionary leader, poet, and former Prime Minister of India. He served as the Prime Minister three times and is widely admired for his inclusive leadership, democratic values, and commitment to national development. Known for his eloquence, integrity, and statesmanship, Vajpayee ji played a key role in strengthening India's global standing, promoting economic reforms, infrastructure development, and peaceful diplomacy. His birth anniversary, observed on 25th December, is commemorated as *Good Governance Day*, highlighting his ideals of transparent, accountable, and people-centric governance.

VEER BAL DIWAS

Date- 26/12/2025

Veer Bal Diwas is observed every year on 26 December to commemorate the extraordinary bravery and supreme sacrifice of the younger sons of Sri Guru Gobind Singh. On this day in 1705, Sahibzada Zorawar Singh Ji (9 years) and Sahibzada Fateh Singh Ji (7 years) were martyred by the Mughal ruler Wazir Khan at Sirhind for refusing to abandon their faith and principles. Despite their tender age, the Sahibzadas displayed unparalleled courage, unwavering faith, and moral strength.

They chose death over conversion, becoming eternal symbols of truth, righteousness. In recognition of their martyrdom and to inspire young minds, the Government of India declared 26 December as Veer Bal Diwas in 2022.

The activity titled “Veer Bal Diwas” was successfully conducted on 26/12/2025 at 04.00 pm at the AESCOP, Ground Floor Lobby. PANJABRAO DESHMUKH JAYANTI

DATE- 27/12/2025

Hon. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh (27 December 1898 – 27 December 1982), popularly known as *Dr. Panjabrao (Bhauasaheb) Deshmukh*, was a distinguished educationist, freedom fighter, agriculturist, and visionary leader from Maharashtra. He was the first Agriculture Minister of independent India and played a pioneering role in the development of agricultural education, cooperative movement, and rural upliftment. He was the founder of the *Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati*, which significantly contributed to expanding access to education in rural and backward regions. His birth anniversary is celebrated to honour his lifelong dedication to education, agriculture, and nation-building.

Hon. Panjabrao Deshmukh Jayanti was observed on 27th December 2025 at 04:00 pm in the Ground Floor Lobby of AESCOP with great respect and enthusiasm. The program was organized to commemorate the birth anniversary of Hon. Dr. Punjabrao (Bhauasaheb) Deshmukh, a renowned educationist, freedom fighter, agriculturist, and the first Agriculture Minister of independent India.
