ABOUT MAHARANA PRATAP

Maharana Pratap Singh was one of the greatest warriors and rulers in Indian history, renowned for his unwavering courage, patriotism, and commitment to safeguarding the sovereignty of Mewar.

Born on 9 May 1540 at Kumbhalgarh Fort in Rajasthan, he belonged to the illustrious Sisodia Rajput dynasty and became the ruler of Mewar in 1572.

Maharana Pratap is best remembered for his heroic resistance against the Mughal Empire and his determination to preserve the independence and dignity of his kingdom. His remarkable leadership and resilience during the Battle of Haldighati in 1576 continue to inspire generations.

Refusing to surrender despite immense challenges, he chose a life of hardship in forests and mountains rather than compromising the freedom of Mewar. Today, he is revered as a symbol of valor, self-respect, sacrifice, and national pride.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND



• **Birth:** Maharana Pratap was born on May 9, 1540, in Kumbhalgarh Fort, Rajasthan.



• **Dynasty:** He belonged to the Sisodia clan of Rajputs, ruling the kingdom of Mewar.



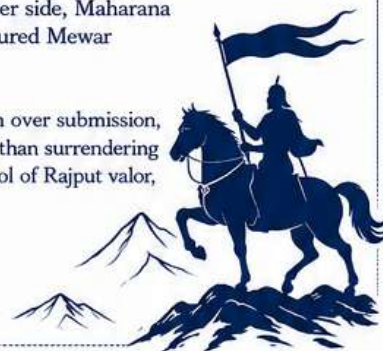
• **Reign:** He became the king in 1572 and ruled until his death in 1597.



• **Key Battle:** He is most famous for the Battle of Haldighati (1576), where he fought against the Mughal forces led by Man Singh I of Amber under Emperor Akbar. Although the battle was not a decisive victory for either side, Maharana Pratap's courage and tactical retreat ensured Mewar remained unconquered.



• **Legacy:** Maharana Pratap chose freedom over submission, living in the forests and mountains rather than surrendering to Mughal rule. He is celebrated as a symbol of Rajput valor, self-respect, and patriotism.
