Date- 28-11-2025

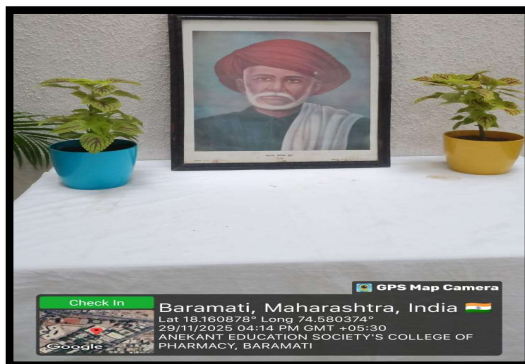
